


How To Read Your Proportional Chart

A numerology chart consists of dozens and dozens of different numbers based on your name and date of birth and can be quite intimidating. However, for those who just want a quick but accurate impression, the Proportional Numerology Chart is ideal; it shows which numbers dominate and which are less prominent in your personal numerology chart, and what that means.

- 1: Drive, determination, individuality, independence, forceful, leadership, original, aggressive.
- 2: Cooperative, gentle, diplomatic, peacemaker, sensitive, intuitive, resilient, graceful, sophisticated, non-confrontational.
- 3: Creative, verbal, witty, inspiring, upbeat, self-expression, irresponsible, scattered.
- 4: Reliable, trustworthy, punctual, detail oriented, patient, management, organization, workaholic, bit of a stick in the mud.
- 5: Loves freedom, dynamic, impulsive, quick thinker, easily bored, adaptable, flexible, non-conventional, adventurous, courageous, risk-taker.
- 6: Harmonious, loving, caring, self-sacrifice, personifies father-motherhood, family oriented, teacher, healer, comforting.
- 7: Wisdom, spirituality, introvert, studious, serious, likes to be alone, quiet, can be cynical. Seeker, searcher, philosopher.
- 8: Drive and ambition, authoritive, detached, power and money, business oriented, visionary, bullish, greedy.
- 9: Humanitarian, sacrificing, global awareness, giving, worldly, sophisticated, political, generous, aloof, arrogant.

Numerologist Hans Decoz developed the proportional chart in 2001. He understood the importance of the location of a number and assigned a value to the numbers based on that. Your Expression number, for example, carries more weight than your Personality number, while your Life Path has a higher value than the Expression.

Fun fact: Your <u>Life Path number</u> is the most important number in your chart but for some of us it's NOT the most dominant number.

Overall, nineteen numbers in your chart are taken into consideration, including some lesser-known aspects such as your Cornerstone and Rational Thought numbers. For the purpose of accuracy, Master numbers are reduced to single digits, because their impact is that of the single digit number when viewed in proportion to other numbers in your chart.

The result is the graph below that shows which numbers dominate your chart.
